Rules of Entry

Entries must be received by 5pm on Wednesday 30th September 2009. Contestants may enter all categories. Entries are limited to one image per category. Entries should include details of location and date for each image submitted. Images may be either in colour or black and white. Digital images must be submitted on disk/CD accompanied by prints (minimum size 6"x4"). Film images must be submitted as either negatives or transparencies accompanied by prints (minimum size 6"x4"). Negatives and transparencies will be returned after the competition closes at the request of the owner. All photographs entered must have been taken between 1st January 2009 and 30th September 2009. Your entry must be entirely your own original work, previously unpublished, not defame anybody nor breach any copyright. If your photograph features any recognisable person or people, written permission should be obtained for the image to be entered in the competition and to be published online and in all media as required. Written permission from each recognisable person (or their parents/guardians if under 16) should be submitted for each entry. Neither you nor your immediate family may be involved in the running of the competition. You must be an amateur photographer. Winners will be notified by 21st October 2009 and invited to attend a prize-giving ceremony. Results will be posted on www.dartmoorpreservation.com by 30th October 2009. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. You must comply with all rules to be eligible for the prizes. Prizes are awarded as vouchers redeemable at the London Camera Exchange in Exeter. By submitting your photograph to the DPA you agree to grant them, free of charge, the right to publish the photograph online and in all media as required. You will retain copyright and will be credited if your picture is used. The DPA reserves the right to cancel this competition at any stage.
